**Exam-2, 3 & 3 “Dermatoglyphic
Indentation” Introduction**

What is Dermatoglyphic?

It means: dermatoglyphic (as in “wrinkle” or Indentations) n.: the grooves that form indentation patterns and wrinkles on the skin (especially on the fingertips and the palms of the hands and the soles of the feet)

How Medical Epigenology Works

examines both Hands and Wrists in their entirety. By assigning a title for each test and a corresponding “**Dermatoglyphic Interpretation Numbers**” (**DI-Numbers**). Then it becomes easy to build a research computer Data Bases. As such this DB allows the exam titles and their **DI-Numbers** to be used separately. Hence the examiner can now focus entirely on their examination at hand recording the clients **DI-Numbers** on a worksheet. Epigenologist’s Clients worksheets can now be sent to a computer centre whereby the worksheet are processed and a report sent directly to the client or medical professional requesting the Medical Epigenology examination. The value of using a Computer DB is that its able to control an infinite number of variations too complex for the human brain to perform.

For example: Exam-1

It performs physical, visual, touch and uses the odd Q & A interpreting descriptive features such as: Physical injuries, Psychological matters, Character traits, Genetic skill sets, Epigenetics and diagnosing and/or confirming illnesses to name a few.

Exams-2, 3 & 4

Focuses mainly on the hands unique “**Dermatoglyphic Descriptive Indentations**” (**DD-Indentations**) features. Just like **Exam-1** it to can interpret Psychological matters, Character traits, Genetic skill sets, Epigenetics to name a few. But understand **Palmography’s DD-Indentations** appears like a city road map. Hence the examination of **Exams-2, 3 & 4** is broken down into **Major** and **Minor DD-Indentations** just like a road map. It makes it easy to follow including if the examiner must take a break allowing them to carry on at anytime (Go to the **DD-Indentations Map** in the next few pages to view it). But first, a little reading is required so the Epigenologist can understand why examining hands can be both fun, quick and easy to perform.

The **Dermatoglyphic Descriptive Indentations** will contract, expand and split like a river in a flood, drought or heavy winds. This is mostly what we do to ourselves when living in unique environments. All as a direct result of influential living events and the effect our environment has in altering our **HOX Genes** allowing them to override our original genes so

we can survive as a conscious species. Some of the minor DD-Indentations features could be coincidental because of human socialization. When these changes occur, they will appear, cross the palm, disappear, strengthen and so on. Most of them change prior to the occurrence of some illnesses or influences. DD-Indentations features just beginning to form show emotions and ideas just starting.

Foresight

Also understand **DD-Indentations** examined beyond a persons’ current date of examination is identified as a foresight (Future projection or destinies) not actual fact. But if the individual doesn’t change their environment for whatever reason the Future projection will occur, be forewarned. A conscious effort to avoid any tragedy must ensue. It saved the author’s life when he was projected to die of a massive heart attack at age 55. Now his DD-Indentations exam shows a new extension of his life whereby the DD-Indentations doesn’t stop at age 55. These projections could be plausible but are not to be determined as actual facts. To change one’s current lifestyle must be done dramatically, over a period of a few weeks or months even years if necessary to alter any DD-Indentation feature. By examining one’s Hands & Wrists frequently allows one to control their life and destinies very easily. Such as a avoiding accidents or illness (cushioning the fall or even arresting them). I, the author, have altered my own destiny several times avoiding many tragic or traumatic living events that could have been detrimental to my health, well being and success in life. In fact as mentioned earlier the author was projected to die at age 55. His DD-Indentations 100 (Head Issues) and other features stopped at age 55. After the author changed his life medically most of his DD-Indentations continue beyond age 55, real proof.

Its incredibly easy

Dermatoglyphic Descriptive Indentations examination is accomplished by following a simple “**Electrical Life Force Theory**.” You may not be aware of an electrical-mechanical force flowing through the body, nevertheless, whether you are aware of this theory or not, its faithful and careful application allows **Epigenologists** to correctly examine or understand any **DD-Indentations** feature generating incredible reports. All without having to interpret any them. Its the computer computer DB that does it for the examiner generating amazing medical reports and insights for their clients and others. Thus, it is fascinating to discover that following this theory works incredibly well and efficiently when applied properly.

To learn how to examine **DD-Indentations**, imagine that an electrical life current is in operation along a any **DD-Indentations**. It begins by entering through the 1st finger and reaching **DDI 095 Heart issues, 100 Head Issue** and **105 Life Issue**, etc. Accomplished in one flow setting in motion an awakening force starting with the **DDI 095** heart issue, **100 head issues** and **105 life issue** of a person **DD-Indentations** associated with their environment. After the **095 Heart Issues DDI, 100 Head Issues** and **105 Life Issue** begins to operate. The current exit from them traveling upwards through the **120 Work Ethics issues** and **Unusal Events Issue** (125 Fate, 130 Health Issues, etc) and finds its outlet through the 2nd, 3rd and 4th fingers respectively. It is not until the

current reaches a **DD-Indentation** that it begins to operate. So, because the **120 Work Ethics issue** receives the current from the end of the **105 life issues DDI**, it is examined from the bottom of the Palm upwards. The **125 Fate issues** and **Unusual Event** (125 Fate, 130 Health Issues, etc) **DD-Indentations** are examined in the same direction.

To cover the infinite number of possibilities when examining **Descriptive Dermatoglyphic Indentations** they have been broken down into smaller portions incorporated in the second, smaller numbers of the **DD-Indentations** identical in all of them. The beginning of **DD-Indentations** cover early years of life, “**_03 — Starting Point.**” The middle portion covers the middle years of life, “**_05 — Course.**” And the ends of the **DD-Indentations** cover the ending years, “**_06 — Termination.**” Please remember to match only what is in your hands to the pictures whether Exams-1, 2, 3 or 4.

Marks, defects, Chance, Worry and Sister DD-Indentations

Each **DD-Indentation** indicates **first**, the physical effect; **second**, mental characteristics and qualities of affection (love, hate and so on); third, the times when this mental attitude has exerted an influence powerful enough to draw **DD-Indentation** in different directions.

characteristics that are wide, deep and unbroken indicate that the characteristics revealed by these **DD-Indentation** are strong. Other **DD-Indentations** such as breaks, tridents and dots, lessens the strength of the **DD-Indentation** characteristics and are also referred to as “**marks**” and/or “**defects.**”

A **DD-Indentation** with a mark or defect as part of it can be interpreted as a **positive** or **negative** interruption to life. If there are also similar marks or defects on other **DD-Indentations** and at the same age. This is a physical indication... But if it's a major **DD-Indentation (095 Heart Issues)** showing no marks or defects or similar characteristics at that age, it is an emotional indication. Marks or defects may be close to a **DD-Indentation** but usually occur on or close to a Mount (Metacarpal Pad).

These names imply their significance: Chance and Worry **DD-Indentation** indicate a continual state of worry or that a person takes many chances on a daily basis, often without being aware of it. They should be disregarded except as an indication of the individual's tendency to worry. These Chance and Worry **DD-Indentation** appear and disappear frequently on the Active hand. If they appear on both hands, this is a permanent Epigenetic characteristic.

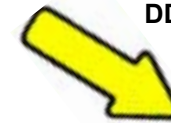
Sister **DD-Indentation** run parallel to major **DD-Indentation** and may be the same length or shorter. They are always good to have. If there is a mark or defect on the major **DD-Indentation**, the Sister version is a sign of repair. If there is no mark or defect, the Sister version makes the characteristic indicated by the **DD-Indentation** even stronger.

Dermatoglyphic Palmography

Palmography defines **Dermatoglyphic Descriptive indentation** for Exams 2, 3 and 4, have all been given a name that defines their purpose along with a set of three separate numbers similar to the 1st exam numbers. By adopting a standard numbering system it becomes very easy to examine any **DD-Indentation** in their infinite format including the ability to translate any marks found on or near them as well. This unique system also allows **Medical Epigenology Computer DB** to decipher hundreds of millions of variations, for any client/Patient, very accurately. No matter how complex the palm of hands may appear. The first large **DD-Indentation** number attached to each name has been incremented by 5. Therefore, the first large **DD-Indentation** number **095** identifies **Heart issues**. For example;



- Heart Issues 95_DD-Indentation**
- Head Issues 100_DD-Indentation**
- Living Events Issues 105_DD-Indentation**
- Unusual Issues 135 to 170_DDI**

The second, numbers after the equal (-) keystroke, standard in all **DD-Indentation**, identifies unique marks and defects including marks on or near each **DD-Indentation**. Therefore “**_10**” always represents breaks. The third number “**_006**” represents the **6th** type of break and so on. Please remember not all of these **DD-Indentation** or marks will appear in every hand. All illustrations throughout the manual are larger than normal for clarity.

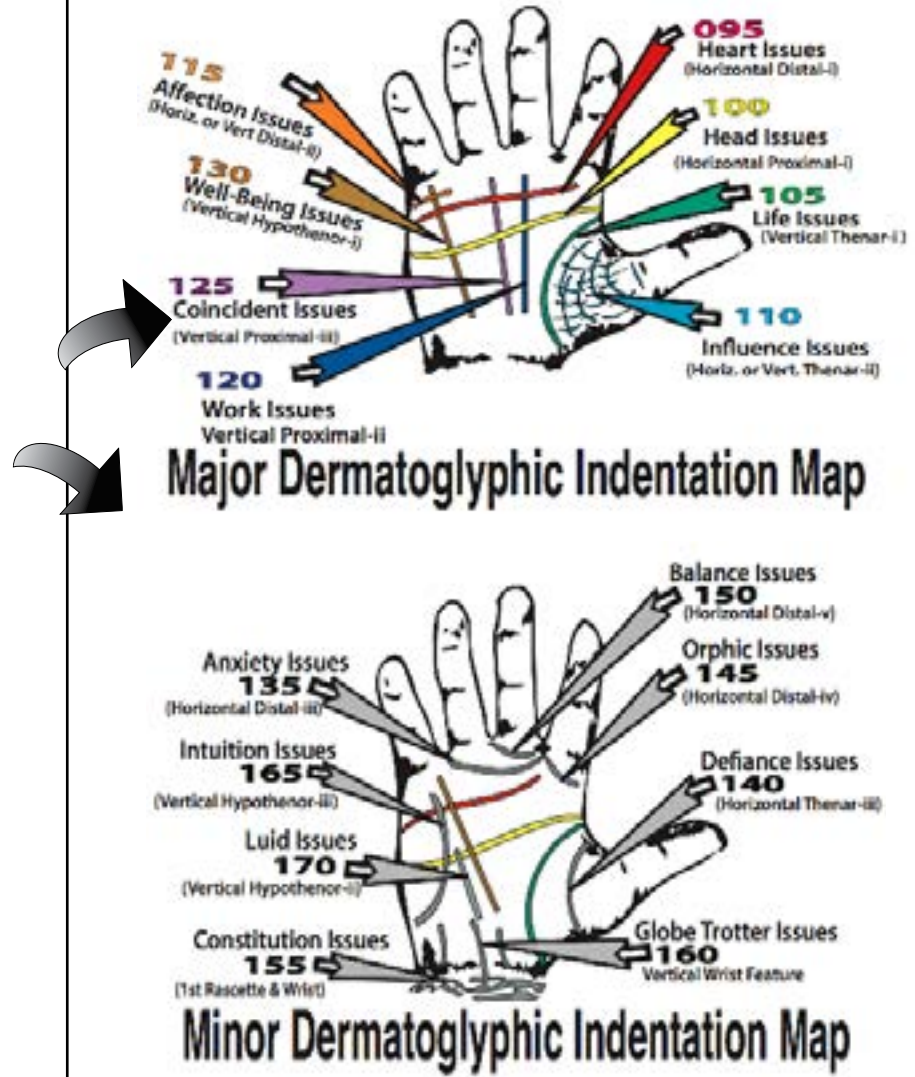

(DDI) Palmography Map**

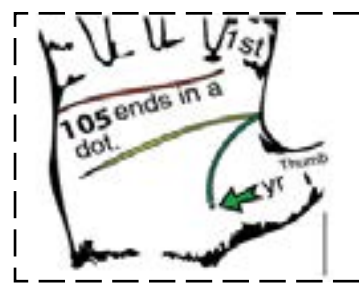

The “arrows” indicate where the examiner should focus.

An “ALERT” indicates an unusual problem exists. If client wants the data record the **DD-Indentation**’s corresponding number, otherwise, ignore it and move on.

The “yr” under a diagram signifies the need to determine the year by using a **DD-Indentation** Year Indicator.

“ALERTS” IMPORTANT NOTE:

Some pictures contain the words “ALERT,” “HLTH - health,” “ACC - accident,” “FEML - females,” “MALE - males” etc. If clients do not wish to have this information, do not record corresponding **DD-Indentation** number. “ALERT(s)” are explained under the “**DD-Indentation**” title numbers and their Alerts.” Use the Contents page.

How Year Indicators work:

If there is a “yr” under the diagram then calculate the age of the mark by using the “**DD-Indentation**’s Year Indicator.” After careful calculation put an “X” on the same line under the age column examiner has defined on any of the **worksheets** for Exams-2, 3 & 4. Some diagrams may have information that can be upsetting to some individuals. Therefore, to control the examination, consider ignoring abbreviations, (**HLTH**) etc. Only if client wish to avoid health data then don’t record or interpret that particular **Dermatoglyphic Descriptive Indentation** number.

Examing DD-Interpretation in 3 Easy Step

1. Begin with either Exams 2, 3 or 4 but first print off many copies of the Requisition, Invoice and worksheet forms for Exams-1, 2, 3 and 4. Prior to any examination these forms must be filled out and signed where Applicable by the examiner and Client. File your copy and attach the client’s report when complete to corresponding worksheet(s). Prepare the worksheets, as shown on **page 157**. *Examine the Active hand first (the*

right hand if right-handed or left hand if left-handed). If *ambidextrous*, examine the **most used hand** as the Active hand.

2. Start at the beginning and record only those distinctive **Dermatoglyphic Descriptive Indentation** numbers you can identify in your client’s hand to a corresponding diagram, not the other way around. *For example, if your client does not have an 115 Affection Issues or you cannot identify a certain mark ignore it and continue on. It’s better to omit than to make a wrong selection. When in doubt leave out and remember, it is not necessary to read or check every Dermatoglyphic Descriptive Indentation or diagram.*
3. Upon completion of your examination the client’s consent form, Images and worksheet along with the client, etc with the same name as the service becomes the property of the client so they can interpret their selected **Dermatoglyphic Descriptive Indentation** numbers in private. *Its that simple!*

It is not necessary to read or check every **DD-Indentation or diagram**. Record only those **DD-Indentation numbers you can identify**, not the other way round. All you have to do is:

1. Match the **DD-Indentation** and **marks** in clients hand to the diagrams.
2. Record the numbers from under the diagram onto the worksheet.
3. Upon completion the worksheets and Report belongs to the client.

It’s that simple! This method is good at parties and family gatherings but to develop a complete and accurate examination, use the worksheets and the Year Indicators to record all the **DD-Indentation** corresponding numbers you have selected.

Exams 2, 3 & 4 is about events that:

- a) have occurred in the past,
- b) may occur if you continue on the same direction in life,
- c) could change if you so desire it.

Remember, not all projections will occur if one alters any one of their major living events. Therefore, DD-Indentation report(s) which refer to any projections after the date of examination (based on year & date of birth) can only be interpreted as an insight. For example, if your client are 30 at the time of an examination, any statements after this age can only be interpreted as a projection, not fact. Also keep in mind DD-Indentation change weekly, monthly and yearly and future examinations can produce different results.

Golden Rule of Medical Epigenology


No single Dermatoglyphic Descriptive Indentation of the hand can tell the whole story. Like a paragraph in a novel, it’s only one piece of information. To fully understand any examination the DDI numbers should be interpreted together, along with their additional variations, to really understand character traits (human nature), life and future projection based on past and present major Living Events.

Exams-2, 3 & 4 Worksheet Example

The age at which events occurred or could occur is calculated by dividing DD-Indentation relative to the size of the hand. The larger the hand the larger the spaces. Draw an imaginary mark at the midway point of the DD-Indentation being examined, to represent mid-life age as being 36. Each midway point is then divided in half again and again until each equal space represents 5 to 8 years. Start from age 6 and go towards the age of 70.

Dermatoglyphic Indentation Year Indicators



095 - Heart Issues is the first major DD-Indentation from the top of the hand. Starts near 1st finger.



100 - Head Issues is the 2nd major DD-Indentation and starts between 1st finger and thumb. Ends on the outside of the hand.



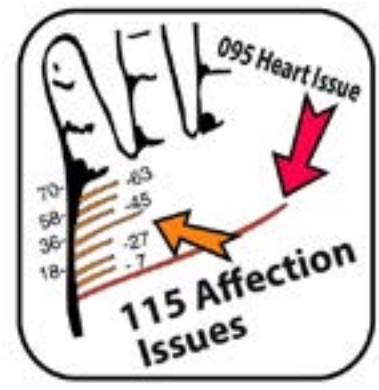
105 - Life Issues is the 3rd major DD-Indentation and starts near 1st finger. Runs parallel to the thumb.



110 - Influence Issues run parallel to the thumb including vertical Influences 110 DD-Indentation on the “G” Mount (Metacarpal Pad).

115 - Horizontal Affection Issues

The Affections Issues are represented by horizontal DD-Indentation close to the end of the Heart DD-Indentation and can be quite numerous. These



horizontal DD-Indentation determine the strength of any affection whether for material things, people or objects. This area is not very accurate alone but is helpful when used in conjunction with the rest of the hand.

120 - Work Ethics Issue starts at the wrist and points to 2nd finger in the palm.



125 - Coincidence Issues starts at the wrist and points to 3rd finger in the palm.

130 - Well-Being Issues starts at the wrist and points to 4th finger in the palm.



140 - Anger Issues is a Sister DD Feature parallel to Life Issue DD Feature close to the thumb.



165 - Intuition Issues starts at the wrist and ends under the 4th finger in the palm. A half-moon shape.



170 - Lascivia Issues runs parallel to the Health and also points to 4th finger in the palm.
